Alpha is an opportunity for anyone to explore the Christian faith in a relaxed manner over ten, thought-provoking weekly sessions. It consists of a series of talks addressing key issues relating to Christianity.

You are invited to come to the first meeting and then decide if you would like to come on the following weeks.

Alpha is for everyone, especially:

- Those wanting to investigate Christianity
- Newcomers to the church
- Those who want to brush up on the basics

Alpha is free. There is no charge for the Alpha course, although you may be asked to make a small donation towards the meal.

Supper There is a light meal together at the beginning of each session which gives people a chance to get to know each other.

Talk There is then a talk on a key issue relating to the Christian faith, and after each talk we divide into small groups to discuss the topic, ask questions and express opinions. Alpha is a place where you can ask any question.

Alpha runs in many denominations worldwide. All the churches provide the same material.

In 2009 over 7,000 courses in the UK and over 30,000 courses worldwide ran Alpha in 163 countries. Over 15 million people worldwide have attended an Alpha course.
